NEED-BASED: Essential home appliances, School supplies, Winter clothing, Car repair for transport to work or school, Wheelchair or specialized medical equipment


OPPORTUNITY AND ENRICHMENT, Education or career training, Computer or iPad to facilitate learning, Camp or summer enrichment
