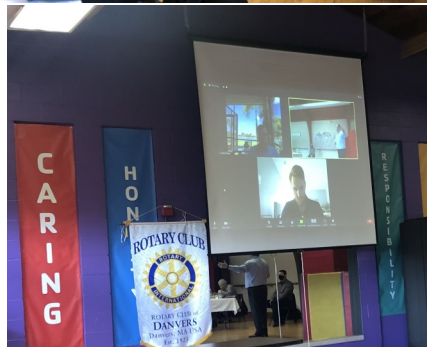

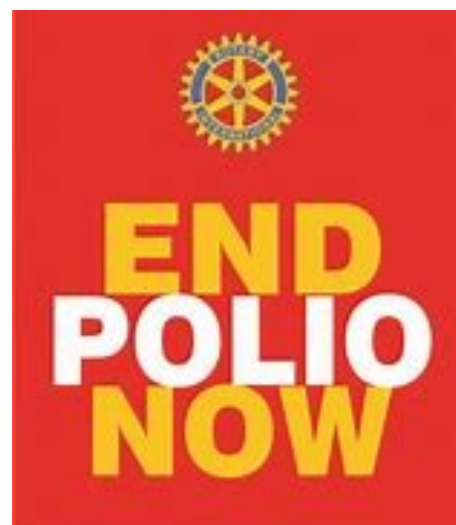


Today's presentation was held at the Danvers YMCA, William Lee Auditorium. GCM, local development firm,

discussed a potential project that could entail 120 residential units and commercial/retail space at the corner of Hobart and Maple Street. GCM is currently performing traffic, development and land studies. 40 % 2 BR, 40% 1 BR and 20% studio/mixed space. The building would be a structure that would mirror the downtown architectural theme and replace the aging commercial buildings that are currently more industrial. The project will help create jobs, assist with making our downtown more vibrant and residential friendly, help with housing needs/shortages, and will allow for more state funding in return making a strong economic impact for the Town of Danvers. Many of those in attendance were able to ask questions on the project. A zoom meeting was also set up for those who could not attend. We had close to 40 community leaders socially distanced in attendance. This event was catered by Daniella's, with a delicious spread. Thank you to David Masse and CGM for treating us to lunch. This event was limited to Danvers Rotarians, YMCA Board of Directors and YMCA Senior Staff.
